How to Book:

- Choose your activities and email or call Scarf to make a booking (07874 221249 or admin@scarfnewforest.org).
- Once we have confirmed if you have a place or are on a waiting list, please pay for your activities in advance of half term either by bank transfer or posting a cheque (see bank details below on booking form).
- Alternatively, complete the booking form below and post it to Scarf together with a cheque (or make a bank transfer), however remember posting takes a few days and some activities fill up quite quickly.
- Please ensure your membership for 2018 is up to date before half term if you would like to come along to an activity.

Monday 12th February, 4-5pm and 5-6pm

Climbing with Nicky at Golden Gecko, 34 Romsey Industrial Estate, Greatbridge Road, Romsey, SO51 0HR

We have booked two sessions at Golden Gecko with experienced climbing instructor, Nicky Cooper-Brown (who runs AACT – Autism, Asperger's Climbing as Therapy, www.aact-climbing.com). Nicky will be taking two groups of ten and teaching climbing skills in the auto-belay section, which Scarf will have all to ourselves. You will need to arrive 15 minutes before your climbing slot to get harnessed up and ready to climb. There's a café right beside the climbing wall selling drinks and snacks. This activity is suitable for all children from age 3 upwards. Younger children will be given priority on the earlier session, and participation forms for each child will need to be completed and brought with you to the session (these will be emailed out once you've booked).

We'd also like to spend a bit of time asking Scarf 2 young people what activities they'd like to do during 2018, so bring your ideas along. Parents/carers do not need to stay as young people will be supported by Scarf support workers/volunteers.

“Early Man” (PG) at The Cinema, Lymington Community Centre, New Street, Lymington SO41 9BQ.

Scarf are having a private viewing of *Early Man* at the Cinema in Lymington. From the creator of Wallace and Gromit, *Early Man* is set at the dawn of time, when prehistoric creatures and woolly mammoths roamed the earth, and tells the story of Dug, along with his sidekick Hognob, as they unite their tribe against a mighty enemy Lord Nooth and his Bronze Age City to save their home. The film starts at 2pm so please arrive by 1.45pm to take your seats – the duration is 1 hour 29 minutes. There will be no refreshments on sale so bring your own (but no glass bottles), but please take all empty packets and cartons with you when you leave. Remember parking can be difficult so leave extra time to find a space.

Scarf have the pool and rapids all to ourselves for this private session. There will be floats and rings available, and you can take a pirate wash under the tipping bucket, climb up to the crows nest and whizz down the long slide, enjoy the rapids and relax in the Jacuzzi. For younger ones there is a pirate ship and a toddler slide in the toddler pool area. Please arrive between **5-5.15pm** to register with the Scarf Meet and Greet. Families should be allowed into the changing rooms at 5.00pm, so be prepared for a quick change to make the most of your hour in the pool. Swimmers over 8 years old do not need to be accompanied by an adult swimming with them. One adult may accompany two children under 8. Both children must be supervised in all areas. Under 4's and non-swimmers must be supervised on a 1-1 basis or must wear floatation aids. If you need support in meeting these ratios, please get in touch with Scarf and we will try to help.

Cost £3 per swimmer (adult or child) – members and friends welcome
